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Context and objective:

Connections between Sesc Educative Programa “Curumim” and the Tabaçu Reko Ypy land in order to provide contact with the culture of the tupi guarani people and present other forms of living in the world to children of São Paulo.

Methodology:

The relationship with the indigenous land has began in 2019 and remained online until the end of the pandemic. The return to the physical activities enabled new meetings with the indigenous leaders at Sesc, and then a camping experience with 49 children in the woods, where they experienced connections with themselves, other children and nature.

Results:

Links with the land, specially between children, in a spontaneous and profound way. Free time and space in the woods to fully enjoy the moment and being touched by the indigenous way of living. As the hosts said, by experiencing those days, children have become knowledge holders for a fairer, more dignified and diverse world.
