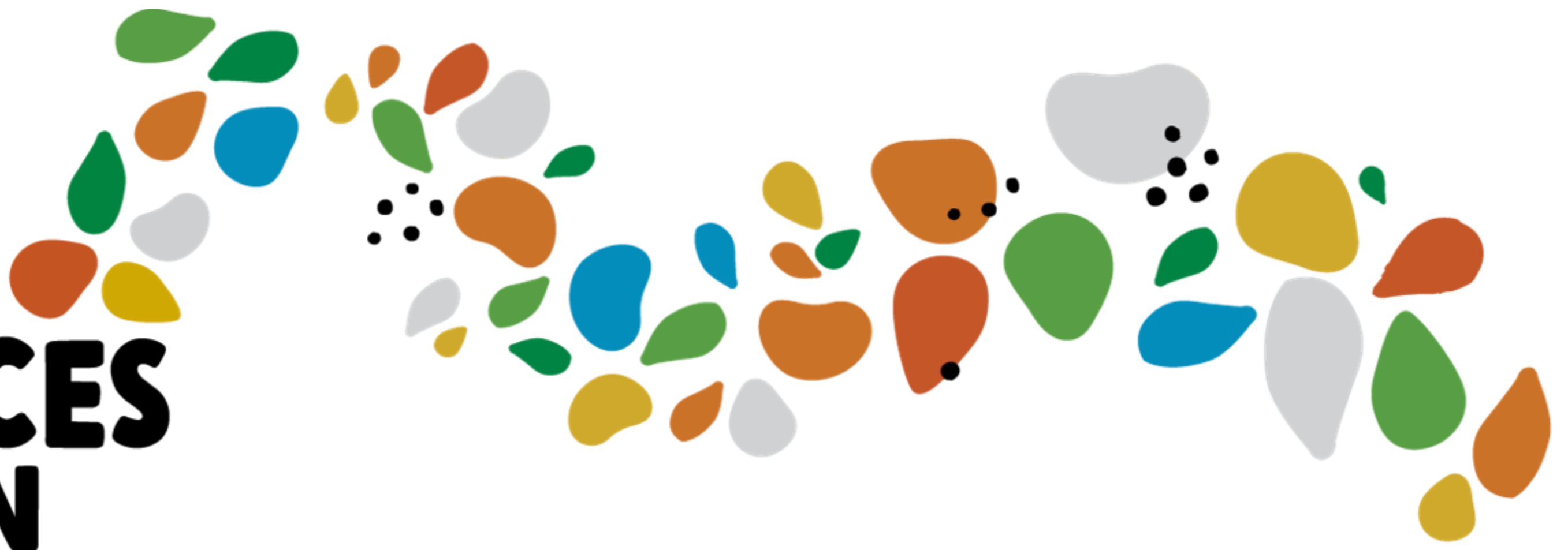

Methodology:

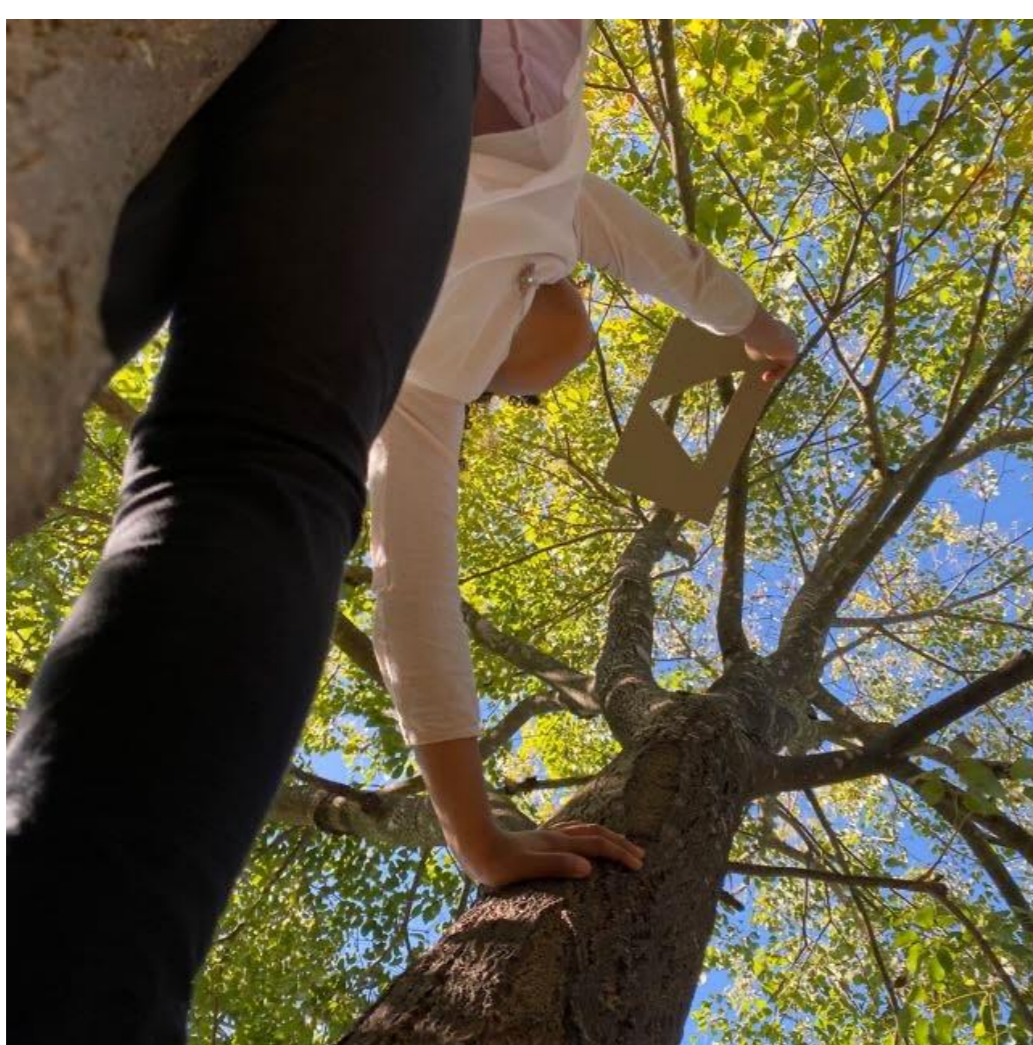
